

Excerpts of CSR Projects for FY 2023-24

Education with Special Focus on Girl Child

Titan Kanya - Girl Child Education

Emphasis of the program lies in providing remedial education, which encompasses both the Government school system and learning centres

- Academic support (Maths and Language) in Govt Schools Karnataka
- DEFG (Digital Enhancement for Girls) Program Enhancing the quality of girl Child education – Tamil Nadu/Other states – Tamil Nadu
- Out of schoolgirls' education (up to learning level 5) Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh & West Bengal,
- Provided academic support, life skills education, career guidance to make 4318 girls future ready for their professional life in 4 Govt Girls Schools in Udham Singh Nagar.
- Covered approximately 18000 girls in the above programs, and 400 teachers through the teacher training program

<u>Kanya Sampoorna</u> - The project targets girl students aged 3-18, focusing on education, life skills, adolescent health, and career guidance in Yadgir district of Karnataka and Cuddalore in Tamil Nadu.- 35000 plus girls covered

Other Education support initiatives.

- Scholarship program for the needy and meritorious children for higher education in TN and Karnataka

Employment Led Skill development programs

- Employability skill development programs
 - For Engineering students
 - For ITI student
 - Implemented Employability Skills program of Naan Mudhalvan of Govt of Tamil Nadu for college students

- Across TN total of 37000 plus students have been skilled across various trades both in our skill centres, Engg colleges and Govt ITI
- Two new Tribal entrepreneurship groups have been formed that has provided livelihood for more than 50 women , and their families in Karnataka
- Entrepreneurship Development- 120 at risk women were trained in West Bengal.
- 774 persons with disabilities were skilled and 527 were placed during the year.

We continue to support 5 Tribal ITI;s in TN as part of ITI adoption program

Overall More than 47000 youth have been benefitted from our Skill interventions

Support for Indian Heritage Arts and Crafts

Multiple interventions in place across the country

- Project Tarasha Creating a platform to connect crafts persons with market
- · Designing, marketing and greening crafts in Uttarakhand
- Craft Skilling and infrastructure support in Karnataka (Differently abled)
- Creating Craft Rural Entrepreneurs in Bihar and West Bengal

Tailored assistance spanning design, product innovation, market access, upskilling, and business development. Comprehensive support has been extended to 10 distinct craft clusters through individual projects, alongside aiding over 40 craft enterprises under Project Tarasha, thereby benefiting approximately 1011 primary and 9895 secondary beneficiaries.

Design Impact programs

The second edition of DIA will now focus on environment and in specific subjects around water.

The Design Impact movement that was launched during the year, has found significant promise in the number of Students who have shown interest on the subject of Design for social good. These entries are now being shortlisted and evaluated for incubation support

Responsible Citizenship

- A project for eliminating preventable blindness in adults and children (TN and Karnataka) through screenings and effective eye care - Nanna Kannu for children, Mobile Rural Vision Program for adults, Vision Centers, Gift of Vision project for elderly people and the unique project called Cataract Blindness Backlog Free Block - a comprehensive approach has been completed. Coverage over 5.0 L beneficiaries
- Holistic environment and Agricultural development in TN Tiruvannamalai and Krishnagiri
- Integrated Village Development Program in Uttarakhand covering 60 village continue, programs such creation of water smart villages, , enhancing value chain interventions, tree plantation, water capacity etc
- Project Vriddhi in Nagaland helped revival of Jalkunds for irrigation, setting up of Hydrophonic farms etc

- During the year, Titan's volunteering program (titled Titan Footprints) was active with a total of close to 33200 volunteering hours involving many employees across the Company either in CSR projects or other local initiatives.
- We also restored a small water body Kalyani in Chikkaballapur
